


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

WHAT IS NAF EMPLOYMENT?

NAF (Non - Appropriated Fund) employment is considered federal employment. It is, however, different from federal civil service employment because the monies used to pay the salaries of NAF employees come from a different source. Civil service positions are paid for by money appropriated by Congress. NAF money, on the other hand, is self-generated by Army clubs, bowling centers, golf courses, and other activities that use NAF employees.

We have two types of NAF positions: "flexible" and "regular". Flexible employees have work schedules that depend on the needs of the activity. These employees may work a minimum of zero hours to a maximum of 40 hours per week, and do not receive benefits. Regular employees work between 20 and 40 hours a week depending on position requirements, and are entitled to receive benefits. All federal job openings (NAF and otherwise) are posted online at USAJOBS.gov.

TRAINING & BENEFITS

Family and MWR offers competitive salaries and benefits packages for regular NAF positions. This includes medical, dental and life insurance. Comprehensive retirement and 401(k) plans are available. The organization will match your monthly contributions up to three percent. There are multiple ways to move upward in Family and MWR through training opportunities and developmental assignments.



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


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

Focuses on supporting Fort Rucker Soldiers, Family members, surviving spouses, and civilian personnel through community involvement. Volunteer opportunities are available both on and off post. Installation volunteer hours are tracked and volunteer opportunities can be recorded in the Volunteer Management Information System (VMIS). Volunteer opportunities may also be available by contacting Army Community Service. Fort Rucker has an active Volunteer Program. Individuals are matched to volunteer positions according to skill, experience and time available. Childcare may be offered in some activities. Participants learn new skills, make friends, and become a part of the community. Volunteering can also be a wonderful way to gain job experience. ARMY EMERGENCY RELIEF (AER) **BLDG. 5700, RM 350** **(334) 255-2341**

Army Emergency Relief (AER) provides emergency financial assistance to Active-Duty Soldiers, Reserve/National Guard Soldiers on Title 10 orders for 30 or more days, Retired Soldiers, their Family members and Survivors. Assistance may be given as a no interest loan, grant, or a combination of both, depending on the situation. Eligible applicants can submit requests 24/7 through the AER Online Assistance Portal at armyemergencyrelief.org. Applicants must provide a valid military ID along with requested documentation supporting the emergency.

The Fort Rucker Employment Readiness Program supports military spouses and dependents with employment assistance and resource referral. Fort Rucker ERP can help you identify on and off post employment opportunities. In addition to connecting with ERP, spouses interested in employment should engage with Military OneSource and Hiring Our Heroes. Military OneSource Spouse Employment and Career Opportunities (SECO) offers access to the Military Spouse Employment Partnership (MSEP), potential education grants (MyCAA), and other benefits like free memberships to LinkedIn Premium, Udemy, and remote job search sites. Provides support to military Families who have special needs. EFMP works in concert with other military and civilian agencies to provide comprehensive and coordinated community support, housing, medical, educational, and personnel services for Families with special needs. Provided services include information and referrals, advocacy, support groups, respite care, relocation assistance, workshops, trainings and special events.



FAMILY ADVOCACY PROGRAM (ACS FAP) BLDG. 5700 RM 350 (334) 255-3898



FAP is dedicated to the prevention of intimate partner and child abuse and neglect. The focus is on prevention and education that helps Soldiers and Families recognize and meet the unique challenges of military lifestyles. FAP provides a wide range of services designed to promote positive family relationships. Services include crisis intervention, stress and anger management classes, marriage/couple communication workshops, parent education, New Parent Support Program (NPSP), home visitation and parent/child playgroups, family life skills workshops and child abuse prevention classes.

FAP offers support and education to the community in relation to Problematic Sexual Behavior in Children and Youth. FAP offers trainings to educate command personnel and military community to recognize signs of possible child abuse and domestic abuse. Emphasis is on prevention, education and prompt reporting.

VICTIM ADVOCACY PROGRAM BLDG. 5700, RM 350 (334) 379-7947

The Victim Advocacy Program provides comprehensive services to victims of domestic abuse by trained professionals who provide non-clinical advocacy services and support to Soldiers and Family members experiencing domestic abuse. Victim advocates are on-call 24 hours a day/7 days a week to provide crisis intervention, safety planning, non-judgmental support, assistance in securing medical treatment for injuries, information on legal rights and proceedings, and referrals to military and civilian resources. A confidential Restricted Reporting option may be available after speaking with an advocate

FINANCIAL READINESS PROGRAM (FRP) BLDG. 5700, RM 350 (334) 255-9631/3765

An education and prevention service that equips Soldiers and Family members with effective financial information and individualized counseling to make informed, confident decisions. FRP offers a wide range of services to strengthen financial well being, build self sufficiency, and reduce stressors. Presentations highlight money management and wealth building strategies, encompassing savings, investment education (to include Thrift Savings Plan [TSP]), debt management, credit analysis, and home buying fundamentals. Congressionally mandated Financial Readiness Common Military Training Milestones (PCS, Promotion, Vesting in TSP, Blended Retirement Continuation Pay, Birth/Adoption of 1st Child, Marriage, Divorce, Disabling Condition, and Pre/Post Deployment) are provided. FRP also delivers consumer awareness, advocacy, and emergency financial assistance information and support. Financial planning can ease daily stress and set the stage for long term success—and it begins with a simple call to meet with an accredited financial counselor.

INFORMATION & REFERRAL PROGRAM, BLDG. 5700, RM 350 (334) 255-3161

Assists service members and their Families (Active Duty, National Guard and Reserve components, Retirees and Dependents, Department of Defense civilians, and their eligible Family members) with information regarding military and civilian resources. Intake evaluations are conducted to link the Fort Rucker community with available and appropriate resources without duplication of effort. ACS is your one-stop location for information. Follow us on Facebook (FortRuckerACS) and Instagram (@fortruckeracs) for resources that promote successful Army living.



RELOCATION READINESS PROGRAM (RRP) BLDG. 5700, RM 177 (334) 255-3735

Relocation Readiness provides information and assistance to military personnel and their families as they transition from one community to another. Soldiers and/or their dependents may request information about their new assignment by visiting or calling the office. Overseas briefs are held to prepare Soldiers and Family members moving to Germany, Korea, Alaska, and Hawaii. Individual relocation counseling is targeted to Soldiers and Families preparing for their first permanent change of duty station or a first overseas Permanent Change of Station. A Relocation Readiness Workshop is offered on demand only for Soldiers and their Families. Information on Army benefits, entitlements, TLE, BAH, per diem and TDY, as well as budgeting and spousal employment are discussed at the workshop. The monthly Newcomers' Welcome is required for newly arrived Soldiers and is open to all ID cardholders and provides information about Fort Rucker and the surrounding communities. Relocation readiness also provides on demand Sponsorship Training for military and civilian personnel.

MOBILIZATION & DEPLOYMENT/ SOLDIER & FAMILY READINESS GROUP, BLDG. 5700, RM 182 (334) 255-2887

Mob/Dep prepares and supports Soldiers and Families during mobilization, deployments, emergencies, and natural disasters. SFRG helps build strong families and bridge the gap between families and units by providing official, accurate command information.

SURVIVOR OUTREACH SERVICES (SOS) BLDG. 8939, RM 10 (334) 255-9639



The Survivor Outreach Services (SOS) Program demonstrates the Army's commitment to Families of the Fallen. Survivors are the loved ones of Fallen Service Members, to include parents, spouses, children and siblings. Support is provided to Survivors from all branches of service and all components, Active, Reserve and National Guard. The program is a holistic, multi-agency approach embracing and reassuring Survivors they are continually linked to the Military Family for as long as they desire. Confidential services are provided based on specific individualized needs. Survivors receive support, advocacy, and assistance via group activities providing peer networking opportunities, benefits and financial counseling/planning, and referral services for military and community resources. Gold Star Families parking has been designated at various locations on Fort Rucker, in honor and recognition of the sacrifices of Family members who have lost a loved one in military service. Survivors are reminded that it is important to keep their support coordinator updated on any changes to contact information to include relocating to a new address so that they can remain connected to the program for as long as they desire.

The New Parent Support Program promotes healthy Families through a variety of services including home visits, support groups, and parenting classes. 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

The School Liaison Program addresses educational issues involving military children. Through partnering with

the local and military community, the School Liaison Officer can provide assistance with a full range of K-12 schools (private, public and home school). The School Liaison Program can also assist with the following: Mobilizing and using community resources to reduce the impact of the mobile military lifestyle on military children and youth. Implementing predictable support services that assist children and youth with relocations, life transitions, and achieving academic success. Providing access for parents, children and youth, schools, commanders, and communities to a wide range of resources that facilitate school transitions. Families living on post in permanent housing, with children in grades prekindergarten through sixth grade, will attend the Department of Defense Fort Rucker Schools. Families living on post are able to choose the local city school district they attend for grades 7-12. Families that decide to reside in off post housing are encouraged to research local schools prior to selecting a place to live. School districts generally do not allow out of district enrollment. Please double check with the Fort Rucker School Support Services or the school district's central services to determine the school district serving your residence. Child & Youth Services offers bus service from Enterprise schools to our after school programs, on a space available basis. If you are in need of bus service from an Enterprise school, please contact the School Liaison Services.

SPONSORSHIP

Relocation Assistance and Transition Assistance are offered by Child and Youth Services through our youth sponsorship clubs, which focus on relocation support and life transitions that military connected children and youth often encounter. Children and youth will find themselves better prepared for and able to cope with any changes and stresses that they may encounter due to their parents' military requirements.

We can also provide parents with access to the tools necessary to guide their children and youth through relocation and life/school transitions-allowing parents to focus on their military missions.

WHY JOEY'S BREW?

All detachments have a patch that represents a campaign or operation. These patches serve as a visual reminder of a soldier's contributions and experiences while on deployment.

Going above and beyond the call of duty, Michael "Mike" J. Novosel Sr., served two tours as a commander of a medical evacuation helicopter.

In 1969, Novosel volunteered for his second tour to Vietnam. The chosen patch for this tour had a kangaroo and her Joey, a baby kangaroo (see right). This design was represented on the 82nd Medical Detachment War Patch-55.

The Joey symbolizes all the medical evacuees that were flown out by dust-off pilots and their helicopters (the mother kangaroo).

The logo includes a patch on the kangaroo's arm (facing left), the dust-off symbol.

Novosel flew a total of 2,543 missions transporting more than 5,500 medical evacuees.

Joey's Brew is a nod to Medal of Honor recipient, Michael J. Novosel Sr., and the 82nd Medical Detachment.



The Fort Rucker Riding Stables is located on Hatch Road just south of the Silver Wings Golf Club, surrounded by over 10,000 acres of beautifully wooded trails. The complex includes a clubhouse with bathroom facilities. Four community pastures, 40 duplex barns with individual tack rooms and paddocks are available on-site as well as 24 stalls for transient and show horses.

The Fort Rucker Riding Stables has two regulation dressage rings and three breaking pens. A lighted western arena and lighted jump/show arena, covered farriers' shed and double wash stalls with warm water are also available to patrons. If you have a horse that needs boarding, please contact the Riding Stables for arrangements.

HISTORY OF THE BEAR

Located across from the U.S. Army Aviation Museum, Sgt. Ted E. Bear has stood watch over Fort Rucker for the last 65 years.

Originally designed in Panama City by Lee Koplín in 1961, Sgt. Ted E. Bear was assembled here on Fort Rucker. Sgt. Bear has been a Fort Rucker icon ever since.

Why a polar bear? Sgt. Bear was erected as an emblem of the 2nd Battle Group, 31st Infantry Regiment, also known as the Polar Bear Regiment.

Deployed in 1918, the Regiment spent two years in Siberia, protecting allied interests and guarding the Trans-Siberian railroad. The Regiment eventually became known as the "Polar Bears."

In 1961, to commemorate the action the unit experienced, Col. Bennett L. Jackson commissioned the construction of a polar bear statue.

It wasn't until 1997 that Sgt. Bear had received his original rank, Pfc. Ted E. Bear. A decade later, an official ceremony was held in Sept. 2007 by Maj. Gen. Virgil L. Packett II, to promote Pfc. Bear to sergeant.

Throughout the years, Sgt. Bear has made his rounds throughout the base. In 2008, he received his orders to be placed across from the U.S. Army Aviation Museum.

Currently, Sgt. Bear is assigned to the MWR marketing team, who take great pride and care when it comes to his wellbeing.

Throughout the year, you can catch Sgt. Bear in an array of outfits. His wardrobe consists of Santa outfits, bunny costumes, and even flight suits.

Sgt. Bear overshadows all of his fellow sergeants, if not by age then by dimensions! At 15 feet high, he weighs over two thousand pounds (mostly solid concrete). With every new painted outfit, Sgt. Bear's weight increases.

For generations, Sgt. Bear has remained a staple of the Fort Rucker Community and joins the journey of past, present and future aviators.

With visitors year-round taking part in all of what Family & MWR has to offer, the lake is a never-ending outlet for outdoor enthusiasts. Lake Tholocco offers



numerous recreational activities, such as boating, water skiing, swimming and fishing. Other facilities available include fishing piers, beaches, pavilions, restrooms, picnic areas and much more. Cabins and RV spots are available on a nightly basis.

CABINS

Enjoy panoramic views of Lake Tholocco and Fort Rucker's scenic landscape from one of the 23 lovely cabins. These top-notch recreational lodging facilities overlook the banks of Lake Tholocco and offer active duty, retired military personnel, DoD APF/NAF civilians, and authorized guests a memorable stay. Our cabins offer fully equipped kitchens, a furnished living space, satellite TV, and a screened-in back porch with picnic table and grill. We have 21-two bedroom cabins and two-three bedroom cabins. There is a community fire ring on both the East and West side of Lake Tholocco for guests use.

EAST BEACH LODGE

Fort Rucker's newly constructed Lake Lodge is situated on the East Beach of Lake Tholocco. The Lake Lodge features 20 resort rooms with panoramic views and furnished balconies. Continental breakfast is included with each stay. Coin-operated guest laundry is available at the lodge as well as a variety of drinks and grab and go items in the lobby. A large banquet hall with seating capabilities for 145 guests compliments the Lodge, and in conjunction with Welcome Home Catering welcomes events from intimate gatherings to extravagant weddings, and everything else in-between. ENGINEER BEACH RV PARK

The paved campground has 18 long-term sites and 30 short-term sites, all with 40-foot concrete parking pads. All sites have electric and water hookups, excluding our four tent camping sites. Also available: a waste station, climate controlled Recreation Room, bathhouse with rest rooms and shower facilities, and a fully equipped coin-operated laundry room.

Lake Tholocco is a 676.8 acre lake that offers numerous recreational activities. Boating, skiing and swimming are favorite sports at the lake. Facilities include two fishing piers, beaches, pavilions, and clean restrooms.

COVERED FLOATING BOAT DOCK SLIPS

A floating boat dock is available at West Beach Marina for patrons to store their personal watercrafts for a daily, monthly or yearly fee. Please call Outdoor Recreation for prices and availability.

LAKE THOLOCCO WEST BEACH SWIMMING AREA

Cool off during the hot summer months between Memorial Day weekend and Labor Day weekend at the West Beach Swimming Area. This popular summer retreat boasts two large slides. Life jackets are available. Swimming is allowed only when life guards are on duty. For more information on swimming on Fort Rucker please contact Swimming and Aquatics at **(334) 255-9162**.

FISHING & HUNTING

Fort Rucker offers a variety of outdoor recreational activities, including fishing and hunting. Anglers can try their luck for largemouth bass, catfish, crappie, and bream at several excellent lakes and ponds, such as Lake Tholocco, Beaver Lake, Buckhorn Lake, Ech Lake, Beaver Pond, and Parours Lake (which is reserved for youths under 16). For hunters, both big and small game are available.

To hunt on the installation, individuals aged 16 and older are required to have both an Alabama State License and a Fort Rucker Post Permit. Additionally, all hunters 16 and older must possess a valid hunter's education card. If you need a card, you can complete the course online at outdooralabama.com or attend a state-run class.

The Alabama State license can be purchased at the Outdoor Recreation Service Center, while the Fort Rucker Post Permit can be obtained online at www.rucker.isportsman.net. To qualify for resident pricing on the state license, military personnel and their dependents stationed at Fort Rucker must present a copy of their orders along with a military ID and hunter safety card if they do not have an Alabama driver's license.

Exceptions to these rules:

- Youth aged 15 and younger do not need a State License or a Post Permit.
- Alabama residents over the age of 65 are exempt from needing a State License but must still obtain a Fort Rucker Post Permit.

Both state licenses and post permits expire annually on August 31 and must

be renewed. For a complete guide to rules, regulations, and permit prices, please refer to Fort Rucker Regulation 215-1, which is available online at www.rucker.isportsman.net.

EQUIPMENT CHECKOUT CENTER

For that special family outing, Outdoor Recreation (ODR) offers several items to aid in the fun and enjoyment for your entire family. Pontoon boats, ski/wake board boats, fishing boats, water tubes, jet skis, canoes, kayaks, and paddle boards are available for use at Lake Tholocco. For those family reunions or school fund raisers, ODR offers picnic pavilions, inflatables, multiple party game sets, BBQ cookers, canopies and dunking booths. For camping enthusiasts, ODR has travel trailers.

Outdoor Recreation oversees picnic areas at Lake Tholocco (West & East Beach), Beaver Lake, and Buckhorn Lake. Patrons will need to reserve pavilion areas through Outdoor Recreation.

Picnic areas are authorized for use on a first come, first served basis, unless reserved through the Outdoor Recreation Pro Shop. Reservations are confirmed only after receipt of appropriate fees, and are subject to cancellation restrictions. Units/Organizations must submit a request in writing for organizational days at least five business days in advance.

Equipment Checkout is available to authorized patrons. Fulltime government contractors and personnel with a valid ID badge are also authorized to checkout equipment from Outdoor Recreation Equipment Rental, but may not sponsor a guest.

BENEFITING LOCAL WOUNDED WARRIORS

WOUNDED WARRIOR PROGRAM

RECREATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

Fort Rucker Outdoor Recreation provides Wounded Warriors and Wounded Veterans specialized recreation equipment. Among the items funded with the proceeds from the Wounded Warrior Hunts are an accessible mobile tracked wheelchair which allows a hunter to go over various outdoor terrains, and two hydraulic hunting stands which can be moved to desired hunting locations. The 5x7 ft hunting stands sit on a trailer with controls that allow them to be lowered to the ground (so no ramps needed) and elevated to any height up to 18 ft providing a better field of view for hunting. This equipment makes hunting more accessible for hunters with physical limitations.

A specially designed and customized Rhino Boat named "The Warrior" has been curated to fit the needs of a person with disabilities and allow them to operate the boat or to be a passenger. These features on the boat include a ramp allowing a wheelchair to roll directly onto the boat, specialized controls, remote control automated anchor, wheelchair locking system, and specialized safety features. Patrons can coordinate with the Fort Rucker Outdoor Recreation department for assistance with using the equipment. WOUNDED WARRIOR RETREAT BY THE LAKE

Wounded Warrior Retreat by the Lake is a three bedroom, two bathroom, ADA accessible cabin donated by the Wiregrass Wounded Veterans Committee (WWVC). This cabin makes the great outdoors more accessible for Wounded Warriors and Wounded Veterans with physical limitations. Authorized Patrons, priority reservations, and fee information can be found online at **rucker.armymwr.com**. Fort Rucker Family & MWR provides Soldiers, Civilians, and their Families with a quality of life commensurate with the quality of their service. A FISHERMAN'S PARADISE

Whether you're an expert angler or a casual fisherman, you will enjoy casting your line out on one of Fort Rucker's Beautiful Lakes. Try your luck with largemouth bass, catfish, crappie, or bream. Creel limits posted at each location. All ponds and lakes are open from sunrise to sunset for general recreation and fishing is allowed 24/7.

LAKE THOLOCCO

This 676.8 acre lake is located on West Beach Road and is home to our Outdoor Recreation Service Center, West Beach swimming area, RV Park and Lake Tholocco Lodging. While this location is known for its amazing views and recreation on the shore, its waters offer a fisherman's paradise 24 hours a day seven days a week. Lake Tholocco fishing is open to all ages.

BEAVER LAKE

Surrounded by walking trails, this 7.7 acre lake is open to all ages, from sunup to sundown. Access to Beaver Lake can be found off of 3rd Avenue, by the Fort Rucker Physical Fitness Center's football field.

BEAVER POND

This small fishing pond is open to all ages, from sunup to sundown. Beaver Pond is located off of Andrews Avenue, between Silver Wings Golf Club and the Ozark Gate.

PARCOURS LAKE

At 4.1 acres, this lake is reserved for youth, ages 15 and below. Ages 16 and above may assist youth in fishing, but may not actively fish at this lake. Ages 13 and under must be accompanied by an adult. Parcours Lake is located on Farrel Road, behind Lyster Army Health Clinic.

ECH LAKE

This 7.7 acre lake is open to all ages, from sunup to sundown, however, days of operation are subject to change. To get to Ech Lake, turn from Christian Road onto West Beach Road, then take the first unpaved road on the left and follow the signs to Ech Lake.

BUCKHORN LAKE

This 13.2 acre lake is open to all ages. Buckhorn Lake is open from sunup to sundown, however days of operation are subject to change. The Lake is located two miles past Silver Wings Golf Club on Hatch Road.





ADOPT-A-TRAIL PROGRAM

RECREATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

Have you made use of the extensive network of walking and biking trails on Fort Rucker? If so, consider becoming a volunteer in our new Adopt-a-Trail program!

Adopt-a-Trail volunteers promote community stewardship and bridge the communication between the community and MWR. The Adopt-a-Trail program sends a message that the community cares about its trails. Through monthly visits to your trail, volunteers document maintenance needs, report acts of vandalism, interact with trail users, promote trail safety, and encourage an overall positive use of public trails.

Volunteers have two trails to choose from: the Parcours trail is a walking/running nature trail with 18 fitness stations. This course is relatively flat and easily traversed: the mountain biking trails are rugged nature trails consisting of uneven terrain with hills and dips. Volunteers can indicate which type of trail they prefer to work on, as well as the length of trail under their care.


For when you can't make it in, there's a whole world of online resources, too! Ask us about access to databases for self-help

STORYWALK®



SPORTS • FITNESS • AQUATICS

The Fort Rucker Physical Fitness Center (PFC) is a 64,000 square foot facility offering a variety of cardiovascular equipment ranging from treadmills to Concept2 rowers; LifeFitness selectorized equipment; and a free-weight and dumbbell area with Hammer Strength Equipment. This facility offers a fully equipped functional fitness area with a rig and artificial turf.

A variety of auxiliary equipment such as jump ropes, weight belts, racquetball equipment, mountain bikes, and more is available for patrons to sign out and use. This facility is equipped with one racquetball court, two additional functional fitness rooms, a 25-meter indoor pool, outdoor multi-purpose fields, a quarter-mile track, 18-hole disc golf course, and a mountain bike trail.

The PFC maintains five running/walking trails around Fort Rucker and can provide runners with a map and trail descriptions. Patrons have access to men's and women's locker rooms with all the normal amenities, including sauna and steam room as well as daily-use lockers. The PFC organizes and hosts a variety of fitness programs and events including personal training services, intramural sports, competitive and non-competitive running events, health-promotion events, Gym Rat Program, and other activities.



PICKLEBALL & TENNIS COURTS

As the popularity of pickleball continues to surge, we invite you to our newly renovated tennis and pickleball courts. Our updated facility is the perfect place for soldiers and their families to enjoy some friendly competition, learn a new sport, and create lasting memories together. Equipment is available to checkout at the main PFC.

SWIMMING & AQUATICS

The Fort Rucker Physical Fitness Center features an eight lane, heated, twenty five meter indoor pool with a low dive, and handicap access. Lifeguard certification courses, swim lessons, water aerobics, and military training are offered.

WALKING TRAILS

Fort Rucker offers two different walking/running trail systems: one located near Parcours Lake and one surrounding Beaver Lake. Each trail offers a customizable experience for runners of any fitness level. The running trails behind Parcours Lake intertwine with bike trails. Different stations are available throughout the trail system such as balance beams, pull-up bars and monkey bars. The Parcours Lake trails contain more than a dozen stations for different workouts and could be ideal for anyone who wishes to incorporate more into their workout. The Beaver Lake trail splits into four unique routes two-thirds of the way into the path. Maps are available at the PFC.

There are no hiking or walking trails available at Lake Tholocco, those areas are reserved for training or hunting.

HELPFUL INFO FROM NAF SUPPORT MANAGEMENT

The Post Solicitation Office is responsible for the oversight of business conducted on the Fort Rucker installation, private organizations, and the coordination of on-post fundraising. Solicitation permits may be issued for individuals conducting business on-post including, but not limited to, Insurance Agents, Financial Representatives, Photographers, Domestic Cleaning Companies, and Home Based Businesses such as Pampered Chef, Mary Kay, and Scentsy.

Please be aware of the following with regards to solicitation on the installation:

- A permit (Fort Rucker Form 44/54) must be issued to conduct business on the installation.
- The permit does not allow door-to-door solicitation.
- All business must be conducted by appointment only and appointments must not be during duty hours.
- Solicitation may not be conducted in mass, group, or captive audiences.
- Agents may not distribute literature on the installation, except to the person that they have a scheduled appointment with. This includes the distribution of flyers and business cards unless specifically requested by a client from the sales representative.

- Agents may contact prospective clients initially by methods such as advertising, direct mail, and telephone.
- Commercial insurance agents are not authorized to give financial planning briefings during military sponsored events.
- Agents are prohibited from having allotment forms in their possession and/or assist in the administrative processing of these forms.
- Personnel in pay grades E-1, E-2, and E-3 are required to be counseled by the commander or designated individual using DA Form 2056, Commercial Insurance Solicitation Record, prior to purchasing insurance. These Soldiers are required to wait seven days from initial counseling before an allotment form is signed and submitted to finance for processing.
- Commanders should have designated areas assigned for agents to meet with Soldiers who live in the barracks. Agents are not authorized in individual rooms.
- Home address of members of the command or unit will not be given to commercial enterprises, or individual agents.
- DoD personnel will not act in any official or business capacity, either directly or indirectly, as liaison with agents to arrange appointments.
- The Department of the Army does not endorse any company or products offered on the installation.

AUTHORIZED PATRONS

Active duty and retired military personnel, Active Duty Coast Guard and their Family Members with valid ID cards are authorized use of all MWR facilities on a priority basis, in accordance with individual facility age requirements.

The following MWR patronage policy for DoD Appropriated Fund (APF), Non-appropriated Fund (NAF) and Coast Guard civilians, Reserve Components, contract civilians, and their Family Members (who meet individual facility age requirements) and their guests established at Fort Rucker, AL.

Participation in, or spectators at, music and theater productions, sporting events, special events and other activities open to the local community to foster public relations, when their participation is an enhancement, are authorized. Patronage privileges will be suspended, terminated, or denied if the installation commander or his delegate determines it to be in the best interest of the activity, program, installation or Army.

BINGO All participants must be over the age of 18 to purchase cards or claim prizes. Bingo callers or monitors, Family & MWR managers, the DFMWR, direct line supervisors, other employees of the sponsoring activity, and their immediate Family Member(s) may not play. Authorized patrons include:

- All members of the United States Reserve Components and their Family Member(s) with a valid ID card.
- Currently employed and retired APF, NAF, and DoD and Coast Guard civilians.
- DoD contract employees working full time on the installation.
- Employees assigned to one or more MWR activity(ies) may participate in bingo sponsored by an unrelated activity.
- Former Prisoners of War (POWs), and spouses of current POWs or Service members missing in action (MIA) and their Family Member(s).
- Non-DoD Federal employees working on the installation.
- Community area residents with no military affiliation may participate in FB&E activities.
- Participation will be in accordance with Bingo operational procedures for nonmilitary patrons, and on a space availability basis.

- Participation will be in accordance with Silver Wings Golf Club operational procedures for nonmilitary patrons, and on a space availability basis.
- Former POWs, and spouses of current POWs or Service members MIA and their Family Member(s).
- Non-DoD Federal employees working on the installation.

INTRAMURAL SPORTS PROGRAM

Civilian personnel and Family Members may not participate with military personnel in individual sports or contact sports (boxing, wrestling, team handball, and football). Authorized Patrons include:

- All members of the United States Reserve Components and their Family member(s) with a valid ID card, who meet age restrictions.
- Currently employed and retired APF, NAF, and DoD and Coast Guard civilians and eligible Family Members residing in the sponsor's

household, as outlined in Memorandum of Instruction (MOI) for each sport.

- Family Members of active-duty military personnel, with a valid ID card, may participate in intramural sports programs when age requirements are met.
- Contract civilians in accordance with the MOI for each intramural program.
- Spectators at sporting events and invited community civilian teams in scheduled tournaments and sport events.
- Former POWs, and spouses of current POWs or Service members MIA and their Family Member(s). Non-DoD
- Federal employees working on the installation in accordance with the MOI for each intramural program.

LAKE THOLOCCO LODGING

Authorized Patrons include:

- All members of the United States Reserve Components and their Family Member(s) with a valid ID card.
- Currently employed and retired APF, NAF, and retired DoD and Coast Guard civilians.
- DoD contract employees working full time on the installation.
- Former POWs, and spouses of current POWs or Service members MIA and their Family Member(s).
- Non-DoD Federal employees working on the installation.
- Guests when accompanied by an authorized patron.

LIBRARY

Authorized Patrons include:

- All members of the United States Reserve Components and their Family Member(s) with a valid ID card.
- Currently employed and retired APF, NAF, and DoD and Coast Guard civilians.
- DoD contractor employees working full time on the installation.
- Non-DoD Federal employees working on the installation.
- Guests, when accompanied by authorized patrons.

Authorized Patrons include:

- All members of the United States Reserve Components and their Family Member(s) with a valid ID card.
- Currently employed and retired APF, NAF, and DoD and Coast Guard civilians.
- DoD contract employees working full time on the installation.
- Guests when accompanied by authorized patrons.
- Former POWs, and spouses of current POWs or Service members MIA and their Family Member(s).
- Non-DoD Federal employees working on the installation.

OUTDOOR RECREATION

Authorized Patrons include:

- All members of the United States Reserve Components and their Family Member(s) with a valid ID card. currently employed and retired APF, NAF, and retired DoD and Coast Guard civilians.
- DoD contract employees working full time on the installation.

- Guests when accompanied by authorized patrons.
- Former POWs, and spouses of current POWs or Service members MIA and their Family Member(s).
- Non-DoD Federal employees working on the installation.
- Fort Rucker Lake Tholocco areas and facilities will remain open to members of the public.

PHYSICAL FITNESS CENTERS

Authorized Patrons include:

- All Active Duty Military and their family member(s) with a valid ID card.
- All members of the United States Reserve Components and their Family Members with a valid ID card.
- Currently employed and retired APF, NAF and DoD and Coast Guard civilians.
- DoD contract employees working full time on the installation.
- Former POW's, and spouses of current POWs or service members MIA and their Family Member(s).
- Non-DoD Federal employees working on the installation.
- Guest Policy-Active Duty, Retired, their family members and CAC card holders may sponsor up to two guests into the Facility.

- Former POWs, and spouses of current POWs or Service members MIA and their Family Member(s).
- Non-DoD Federal employees working on the installation.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES (AUTO SKILLS, ARTS & CRAFTS)

Authorized Patrons include:

- All members of the United States Reserve Components and their Family Member(s) with a valid ID card.
- Currently employed and retired APF, NAF, and DoD and Coast Guard civilians.
- DoD contract employees working full time on the installation.
- Guests when accompanied by authorized patrons.
- Former POWs, and spouses of current POWs or Service members MIA and their Family Member(s).
- Non-DoD Federal employees working on the installation.

FUNDRAISER REQUESTS

Fundraiser Form Instructions (Forms are available from the MWR NAF Support Management Division or online at rucker.armymwr.com): The request must be completed and submitted to DFMWR 30 DAYS PRIOR to the fundraising event. If submitted less than 30 days prior, the event MAY NOT BE APPROVED. Forms should be returned to MWR NAF Support Management, Bldg. 5700 Room 390.

TO COMPLETE THE FORM:

1. Please provide your unit information, soldier family readiness group information, or private organization name.
2. What kind of event are you trying to hold? i.e. car wash, cookie sales, popcorn sales, donation giveaway, etc. NOTE: If you are having a donation giveaway, please annotate what the item is that will be given away on this same line. Example (Item: Xbox).
3. Please provide the date and time of your event. The application may not contain dates for multiple events. However, the application can have multiple dates for the same event. Example of compliant is a seasonal event held over a range of days, i.e. gift wrapping (December 12-14). Example of non-

compliant is scheduling separate car washes on one application (May 15, June 20, etc.).

4. Where do you plan on having this event? Are you having it at multiple sites? List the locations where you plan to raise your funds here. It is your responsibility to coordinate approval with the manager of a facility prior to submitting your request. Please obtain the printed name, signature, and phone number from the locations' management/ commander on the supplemental lines provided. Please attach additional approvals on a separate sheet of paper.
5. Please provide a fee or donation amount that your organization will be accepting during the event.
6. If your event will require military or logistical support, please attach a separate page explaining your intent and the support you would like to request.

If you are a Unit Informal Fund or SFRG you must provide a signed copy of your informal fund SOP. SFRGs require a signature from the battalion level or equivalent prior to being submitted.
