

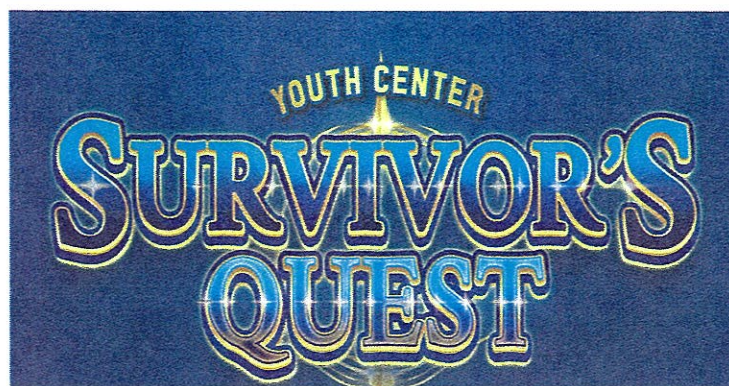

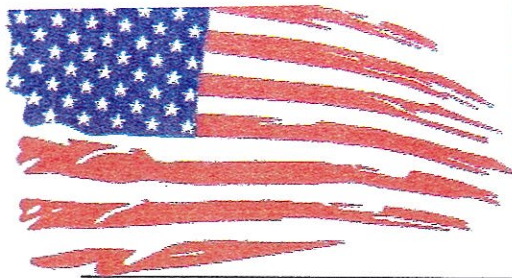

Youth Program Camp Fees

Information Regarding Summer Camp Fees & Policies

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Please review the following important details regarding summer camp fees and policies:

- **Camp Fees & Enrollment:** Fees for summer camps must be paid in advance. You may enroll in multiple weeks at a time, selecting the weeks that best fit your schedule.
- **Outstanding Balances:** If your household has an outstanding balance, it must be paid in full before summer camp begins.
- **MST Patron Fees:** Camp fees for Middle School Teen (MST) patrons are determined based on Total Family Income categories. Please note that MST camp rates differ from those of the School Age Services program.
- **Fee Structure:** Youth Program Summer Camp fees are listed on the Child and Youth Services (CYS) fee chart.
 - If a youth attends more than two days in a week, the full weekly fee applies.
 - If a youth attends for only one day, a daily fee will be charged.
 - If the one-day attendance falls on a field trip day, the daily fee plus the fixed field trip cost will apply.
- **Camp & Open Recreation Hours:** All camps run from **7:00 AM to 1:00 PM**. Open Recreation begins at **1:00 PM**, and youth may stay for Open Rec at no additional cost.
- **Field Trips:**
 - Departure and return times vary by trip and will be listed on permission forms.
 - Please bring your child **30 minutes early** on field trip days for instructions and roll call.
 - Field trips require an additional fee.
- **Meals & Snacks:** Breakfast, lunch, and snacks will be provided during camp and camp field trips. Snack will be provided for Open Recreation.
- **Sibling Discount:** A **15% discount** is available for families enrolling multiple children. This applies to Child Development Center (CDC), School Age Center (SAC), and Middle School Teen (MST) programs.

MST Summer Program Information & Guidelines

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are excited to announce this year's **Middle School & Teen (MST) Summer Program** for youth ages **11-18** who are currently in **grades 6-12**! Our program will be packed with exciting activities and events, ensuring there is something for everyone. Youth will enjoy **cooking, skating, dance & drama, STEM crafts, gaming, painting, photography, bowling, dodgeball, water parks, field trips, and much more!**

Camp Fees & Payment

Camp fees are based on **Total Family Income (TFI)** and must be paid **before the session begins** each week.

Member Responsibilities

Dress Code

- All youth must wear **closed-toe shoes** (tennis shoes or gym shoes) suitable for all activities. **Flip-flops are not allowed in the gym** but may be worn inside the building.
- **Girls:** Tiny two-piece bikinis, strapless, spaghetti strap, halter, or mesh see-through tops are not allowed. **Shorts must be fingertip length.**
- **Boys:** A **belt is required** to prevent sagging pants. **Crocks** are not allowed on the basketball court.

Outdoor Activities

- Youth should bring/wear **sunscreen, bug repellent, and Chapstick.**
- Sunglasses are recommended for outdoor activities.

Behavior Expectations

- Youth must show **respect** for staff, peers, and themselves always.
