S.T.A.R. KIDS PROGRAM

The **Fort Rucker EMS S.T.A.R. Kids Program** allows EMS crews who would respond to the child's home during medical emergencies to become acquainted with the child, the parents, and the equipment he or she uses before a medical emergency arises. It also allows the child to meet some of the paramedics who might respond when they are having an emergency and become familiar with how EMS crews look, act, talk, and can tour the ambulance so it's not such a scary place for them.

A S.T.A.R. Kid is any child that requires Special Technology Assisted Resources.

This may include medical equipment such as:

- Feeding Tubes
- Medication Pumps
- Apnea Or Special Monitors
- Other Technological Assistance

It also includes patients who have:

- Seizures
- Diabetes
- ADHD
- Autism
- Other Medical Or Psychological Conditions
