LABORATORY TEST ORDER POLICY



EFFECTIVE 1 OCT

- LAB will no longer accept lab orders for patients that are not active duty or not empaneled to LAHC.
- The testing must be performed by the MTF or another Department of Defense (DoD) laboratory.
- All outside LAB orders should be submitted to the lab for processing a minimum of 2 business days prior to specimen collection.
