

SCHOOL LIAISON SERVICES



- Enterprise City Schools has raised their tuition from \$500 to \$800 per school year. Families paying for SY 2026-2027 before 2 June 2026 will still pay \$500. Starting 3 June 2026, the new rate of \$800 will be in effect. The last tuition increase was in SY 2022-2023 increasing from \$250-\$500. The tuition helps the receiving district to recoup local property tax support and helps pay for educational supplies.
- Enterprise City Schools will not be offering First Class Pre-K programs at Brookwood Elementary School for SY 2026-2027. Brookwood Elementary School has been experiencing steady enrollment growth in grades K-6th and the district must prioritize facilities and personnel for elementary age students. There are private day care facilities that offer First Class Pre-K programs in our surrounding areas. All pre-k enrollments are based on a lottery, which most are taking place currently and will be ending by the end of March. Families may apply to all private pre-k programs which are accepting applications for the lottery. Transportation is only provided by parents. Only school-based programs require that you be zoned for the district to attend. Please visit <https://prek.alaceed.alabama.gov/> to create an account and apply for the lottery. 


